

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

Pilot and Feasibility Project Grants for Hematology and Bone Marrow-Related Research

The Yale Center of Excellence in Molecular Hematology (YCEMH) announces the availability of Pilot and Feasibility Grants. Three awards of \$15,000 will be awarded for one year. Funds are intended to provide investigators with the opportunity to explore the feasibility of hematology-related studies and to obtain sufficient data to pursue outside funding. The YCEMH Pilot & Feasibility program encourages young investigators beginning a career in hematology and bone marrow stem cell research to apply and also welcomes applications that reflect new directions of research for more senior investigators, and new collaborations between investigators from different departments.

Those eligible to apply include:

- New investigators without current or past NIH research support.
- Established investigators with no previous work in Hematology who wish to explore a hematology or bone marrow stem cell related project.
- Established investigators in Hematology and related disorders who propose to test original ideas that represent a departure from ongoing research interests.
