LETTER OF INTENT

Projects strongly encouraged are those:

- examining behavioral and social factors affecting women's health
- representing a new direction in women's health research
- expanding existing health research to include the study of sex/gender differences
- using an interdisciplinary perspective

We support:

- clinical, basic (translational), health services, or prevention research
- projects resulting in the translation of empirical findings into practice

A Letter of Intent is invited by **Wednesday, October 14, 2009.**

Include a descriptive title (not to exceed 60 characters with spaces) for the proposed project, the name and title of the principal investigator and other key personnel. The Letter can have a maximum of 450 words, and should include a summary of the project, specific aims, and the timeframe needed to achieve the specific aims. Within the word limit, include 100 words stating how the findings of the *proposed project* would have practical implications for the health of women. Awards will be for amounts up to \$35,000 (direct costs only), and for either a one- or a two-year grant duration.

Please submit an original and two (2) copies of the Letter.

ELIGIBILITY:

Full-time Yale Faculty or full-time staff members of Yale affiliated hospitals are eligible to apply. Investigators outside the Yale community are invited to collaborate with Yale or Yale-affiliated principal investigators.

DEADLINE:

The Letter of Intent must be received by the Program Office by **12:00 noon on Wednesday, October 14, 2009.**

The Letter must include the applicant's signature, address, telephone and fax numbers, and Email address. The Letter must be accompanied by an NIH *Biosketch and Other Support* (PHS 398 – Rev. 11/07). The Letter must be typewritten, double spaced, 11-point Arial font, with one-inch margins. Facsimiles will not be accepted.

A full application will be requested from those investigators whose proposed projects are consistent with *Women's Health Research at Yale* funding interests as stated in this notice. Full applications will be due by noon, **Wednesday, January 6, 2010**, and will be peer-reviewed.

The Program does not provide critiques for unfunded proposals.
