



CADUCEUS Accepting Submissions

Caduceus, a collection of poetry, is accepting submissions for its eighth edition which will be published in November of 2010. The collection is sponsored by the Yale Medical Group and Art Place, and its publication has been celebrated with readings at the Yale Physician's Building, the Yale Bookstore and other local venues. The anthology will be available to patients visiting the Physician's building in the reception areas. The collection will have a medical emphasis, however all types and styles of work are sought.

Guidelines: **The Reading Period is April 1 through July 30.** Send up to 5 poems, one poem per page and no more than five pages typed on 8 1/2 x 11 paper. Author's name, address, and telephone number should appear on the top right of each page. **All poems must be the original work of the submitting author - no translations, no simultaneous submissions, previously published can be sent** if the author has the publication rights.

Send a cover sheet with the title of poems submitted, contact information, and a short biography. Include SASE for notification. **No poems will be returned.** If you would like notification that the poems were received send a self addressed stamped post card. All submissions must contain a return address on outside envelope or they will not be opened. E-Mail Submission accepted as attachments in the format above. Authors whose work is accepted will be asked to sign a publication agreement and to send a proofed copy on a floppy disk or electronically via email. Authors will receive one copy.
