BACKGROUND

This Pfizer program supports the development and career track of junior faculty in *public health* interested in pursuing community-based, public health practice research intended to foster academic science and knowledge of public health. These awards are also intended to foster collaborative partnerships between accredited schools of Public Health and state and local departments of public health. Proposed public health practice research must show relevance to human health and to public health challenges.

ELIGIBILITY

- Junior faculty with a doctoral degree employed by an accredited school/program of Public Health at the time of application.
- Must be within first two years of junior faculty appointment
- Candidates must be mentored by a faculty member experienced in practice-based research.
- Candidates must have identified a mentor within the partner Public Health organization with whom he/she will work
- Public Health School/Program must have a demonstrated record of partnership with state and local public health organizations.
- Applicants already in receipt of an R01 award will be considered too senior for this grant.
- U.S. citizenship or permanent resident status is required.

FUNDING

- Awards provide \$65,000 per year in direct costs for 2 years are intended primarily as salary support, but can be used flexibly to support the applicant's salary (including health insurance) and/or the proposed research project.
- Other peer-reviewed junior faculty career development award may be accepted if awarded by other than a private sector pharmaceutical company or related private foundation in the pharmaceutical industry.

NOMINATION LIMITATION

- Yale may nominate one candidate per division/department.
